FAQS ABOUT KIDNEY DONATION

IS KIDNEY DONATION SAFE?

Donating a kidney is considered very safe and associated with minimal long-term risks.

WHEN CAN I GO BACK TO WORK?

Donors typically return to all normal activities within 3 weeks.
